**ORDER REQUIRING CITATION BY POSTING OF
ALL SMALL ESTATE AFFIDAVITS AUTHORIZED BY
TEXAS ESTATES CODE §205.001 Et. Seq.**

On this the 20 day of July, 2015, both Courts find that there is need for an administrative order regarding notice to all parties interested in an estate when an affidavit is filed for Collection of Small Estates Upon Affidavit under Texas Estates Code §205.001 et seq. Although the Texas Estates Code does not expressly provide for citation in these cases, Section 51.001(b) of the Estates Code provides that the Court may, in its discretion, require that notice be given and may prescribe the form and manner of service and return thereof.


The Courts find that creditors and other interested parties should have an opportunity for notice when an affidavit is filed for Collection of Small Estates Upon Affidavit.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that upon the filing of an affidavit for Collection of Small Estates Upon Affidavit under Texas Estates Code §205.001 et seq., the Clerk shall require citation to all parties interested in the estate by posting under §51.053 of the Texas Estates Code.
